The Surrey Hills around the village of Peaslake is the unofficial home of mountain biking / off-road cycling in the South East.

During the week this quaint village is your picture postcard Surrey village, but come the weekend the village is alive with cyclists of all nature and ages.

There is also a large network of walking trails for those that cannot or do not wish to cycle, but still want to be part of the day. The vistas from top of Holmbury Hill and Pitch Hill, on a clear day provide views to the South Coast and back towards the City of London and its Tall Buildings.

Further to the East lies the 2nd highest point in the South East at 294m, Leith Hill and its Tower. Here you can ascend the stairs to the top where you will be met with panoramic views of Surrey and Sussex.

November 2025 sees the launch of Surrey Hills Night Rides, a collaboration with Surrey Hills MTB Co. and the Guide Companion, British Cycling MTB Night Leaders. With Support from Sussex based [Exposure Lights](#) we will be exploring the same trails used in our day rides but in the dark. There may be options for Rental Bikes from the Riders Hub. For 2026, we will be partnering with the [Tanhurst Estate](#), a small vineyard located on the South facing slopes of Leith Hill. The Vineyard will feature as a mid ride break, where you will be able to sample the local wine and cheese and be given a quick tour by the Owner.

RIDE + VINEYARD TIMINGS : INDICATIVE

The following provides an example of how timings would work for a ride, vineyard tour and wine tasting mid ride stop at the Tanhurst Estate at Leith Hill.

• Arrival, light refreshments and welcome.	09:00 hrs
• Bike allocation, setup and briefing.	09:30 hrs
• Ride departure.	10:00 hrs
• Arrive Tanhurst Estate. Tour and Wine Tasting with Cheese	11:30 hrs
• Depart Tanhurst Estate	12:30 hrs
• Ride return.	14:00 hrs
• Lunch at the Hurtwood Inn. ⁵	14:30hrs
• Guests depart.	16:00 hrs

⁵ Monday to Thursday, The Hurtwood Inn only serves food until 14:30, after which the kitchen is closed until 17:30. Friday food is served all day.
